

Tips for your Social Work Interview



Prepping before the interview

Be well prepared for your interview by reading up on the organisation and your own CV. Being well-informed about the role and your capabilities will help you answer questions smoothly without hesitation.

Handle difficult questions effectively

Despite being prepared, there may be a question or two that come from left field! Instead of falling silent or rambling, acknowledge that it is a difficult question and ask the interview to please repeat. This will give you time to gather your thoughts and answer clearly and concisely.





Follow up with the interviewer

A follow-up call or email can make all the difference when an interviewer is torn between two candidates. Make sure to get in touch and check on the status of your interview if you haven't heard back after a week or so.
